Discussion:

• Dr. Viral Dave (Joint Secretary) IAPSM-GC welcomed all the members of Governing Council.

Agenda 1:

- Minutes of previous EC Meeting were read out by Dr. Viral Dave (Joint Secretary-IAPSM-GC). The minutes were unanimously passed.
- The review of action/tasks allotted to different EC members was done:
 - Secretary, IAPSM gave information regarding WASH mentoring Project and IAPSM-WHD Quiz.
 - Dr. Bhavesh Modi gave the detailed information regarding the projects like Evaluation of PPP of Newborn care and evaluation of PPP of CEmOC carried out under flagship of IAPSM-GC. He also shared the information regarding future projects like independent evaluation of public health programme proposed to be carried out under guidance of IAPSM-GC. Wherever required, faculties of Community Medicine from Medical Colleges of the concerned district will be involved and training will be imparted accordingly.

Agenda 2:

- Dr. Pradeep Kumar shared that State level IAPSM-WHD quiz would be conducted on 1st/2nd week of September 2016 from 11.00 am to 5.00 pm and the detailed programme will be shared very soon with all Medical Colleges through the state. The same was welcomed by all EC members.
- It was shared that the national level PG quiz is planned and going to be held in December or January. Smt. N.H.L Municipal Medical College will be the nodal agency for entire India. It was decided that we should support the endveour and plan the state level PG Quiz.
- Website of IAPSM-GC needs to be restructured as there is a security issue in current format and frequently it is infected with virus. For the same, it was decided for revamping of website of IAPSM-GC may be done.

Agenda 3:

• Oration and Award committee has recommended the names of Dr. Paresh Dave for "PARAM" oration and of Dr. Girija Kartha for "NINAD" oration. Invited Member Dr. Pradeep Kumar has suggested that NINAD oration should be delivered yearly rather than alternate year due to increasing number of medical colleges. The suggestion was approved by EC committee and was decided to include as an agenda in next GBM for approval.

Agenda 4

• Secretary shared the information that a proposal is received from Dr. Deepak Saxena, IIPH-G regarding a short online Course on medico legal aspect of public health for students in collaboration with IIPSH-G and IAPSM-GC. It was decided that Dr. Bhavesh Modi from IAPSM-GC and Dr. Deepak Saxena from IIPH-G will be nodal officer for deciding modalities and plan to initiate course. First batch will be a pilot batch and only students of Gujarat will be

selected and then it will be continued for National level with support from IAPSM but managed by IAPSM –GC only.

- In depth discussion was carried out about the areas in which PSM department can have their role in hospital side like Rabies Clinic, Immunization Clinic, under 5 Clinics, ANC clinics, FW clinics, CPGP, Screening Clinic, Clinical Epidemiological Unit, Geriatric clinic etc. It was decided to have a consultation meeting with TAC for establish the multifaceted role of Community Medicine branch at medical college level.
- Dr. Dileep Mavlankar, President has suggested to plan advocacy program for political leaders on public health issues. It was decided that IAPSM-GC can have an advocacy meeting with Leaders of local self government on Public Health issues in Gujarat.
- Dr. Dileep Mavlankar, President suggested and Dr. Bhavesh Modi seconded to prepare and circulate four to eight pages bulletins in Gujarati regarding selected health topics to every taluka or village level health offices/school by our association in collaboration with Health and Family Welfare Department. For the same, IAPSM-GC will make a proposal for funding and send to Government for approval.
- President has given an idea to prepare recently passed MD experts' profile so that it can be used by the prospective employers. Dr. Shashwat S. Nagar has volunteered for preparing a format for profile PG Students pursuing MD in Community Medicine and recently passed PG students will have to submit the same to Dr. Shashwat Nagar. He will communicate the students' profile who are about to complete their residency to relevant job placement agencies in Public Health.
- Dr. Parag Chavda suggested for conducting a workshop of Statistics and Research Methodology. Dr. Parag Chavda had taken responsibility to prepare the proposal on same and also decided to arrange the same at Rural Health Training Centre (RHTC) of Gotri Medical College for 5 days. EC members suggested that workshop should be in two parts; one will be of first contact session and another one will be final contact session.
